King County Aquatics Center, Seattle, Washington

Because of unique acoustical challenges and the requirement for a high quality music system, Jeff used both his years of experience and computer modeling to meet the client's need for this 5000-seat Olympic Pool and Diving venue.

Life Center Foursquare Church, Spokane, Washington

Having outgrown its existing building, the church made plans to move to a multi-construction-phase campus. Working with architectural firm Artios, Jeff designed the 1200-seat Sanctuary with infrastructure and equipment choices that were well suited to support a future expansion to over 2400 seats. Along with appropriate acoustical treatments, high level, professional quality audio, video, and lighting systems were installed that accommodate weekend worship services as well as theatrical and concert performances.

The Vineyard Church, Urbana, Illinois

For this 1100-seat Church expansion project, Jeff designed acoustical treatments and audio, video, and lighting systems within an infrastructure that not only met the client's immediate need for weekend services, dramas, and concerts but also provided for its future expansion to 1800 seats.
